

Quick Guide to Sharing Stories on Social Media



The Jay Nolan Social Media Team is accepting human interest stories to share on Jay Nolan Community Services' social media sites, website, newsletters, and more! We want to share stories of our consumers, families, and staff in the community.

What Kind of Stories Are We Looking For?

A human interest story is a photo, video, recording, or anything else that shares your achievements, struggles, motivation, or other personal story that you or the person you support want to share with the community. Some ideas are:

- **Stories about challenges** that consumes or families have faced and how they have overcome them.
- **A success at work or school** (raise, new responsibility, employment milestone, graduation, etc.)
- **A fun outing** (going out with friends, going hiking, visiting an amusement park, attending a festival, etc.)
- **Hidden talents** (hobbies, artworks, health goals, etc.)
- Other activities in the community.

PR Consent Form: Please have the person featured in the story fill in the PR Consent form and send completed form to socialmedia@jaynolan.org. Consent is everything!

+Yes, we can make posts anonymous! Either don't mention names, or ask to change the person's name.

What Should I Send?

1. A short blurb or description (what happened? Who did what? Why is it special?)
2. Photos or video
